




 Feedback related to syllabus: In the first question, students were asked to grade the course syllabus in respect to competencies expected at end of the course. The responses are given below:






3. Relevance of discipline centric and open centric: When asked how important discipline-centric and open electives are, the responses were recorded as;




4. Feedback on Syllabus: Another question concerned grading the course in terms of student's workload was responded as;





The responses are given below: 37.14% of students marked excellent, 40% marked very good, 20% good, 2.86% average respectively. - **6. Feedback on learning outcome:** When students were asked to rate the significance of a learning outcome, 40 of respondents marked excellent, approx. 31% responded very good, about 26% marked good and 2.86% average.
- **7. Feedback on fieldwork activities:** To evaluate fieldwork activities, in terms of organization, orientation, presentation and logistics; most of the students approximately 74% responded as excellent. this shows the most of the students were happy with the fieldwork related activities.
