Besides the quantitative data collection using interview schedules/questionnaires comprising of sets of questions highlighting various themes around the socio-economic aspects. The qualitative data shall also be collected using key informant interviews with various stakeholders in addition to some FGDs with relevant groups.

Setting up of Impact Assessment Study Unit (IASU):

In order to conduct the Impact assessment study on the Implementation of PMGSY in Kashmir Division an adhoc unit shall be created to coordinate the various activities of impact assessment in the Department of Social Work, University of Kashmir. The unit shall comprise of following.

Field Investigators 12 No's: They shall be engaged for the period of 02 months with aim to collect data from 10 districts of Kashmir division.
