GENERAL MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The text must be in Times New Roman with 1.5 spacing. The manuscript should be in MS WORD accompanied by a hard copy of the text on paper (along with original photographs/tables/graphs if used in the text).

ABSTRACT

All manuscripts must include an abstract containing a maximum of 250 words typed on a separate page.

WORD LIMIT:

The full length paper should not be more than 6000 words (including abstract, tables and references).

KEY WORDS:

Keywords must be mentioned after the abstractplease supply up to five keywords or brief phrases.

FIGURES:

Graphics files are welcomeif supplied as Tiff or EPS files. Multipanel figures(i.e., figures with parts labeled a, b, c, d, etc.) should be assembled into one file.

The minimum line weight for line art is 0.5 point for optimal printing.

ETHICAL DECLARATIONS:

All the contributors are required to mention appropriate ethics declaration (if any) in the methods section of their manuscript.

SIMILARITY INDEX REPORT:

The similarity index report of manuscript must be submitted along with similarity index score, which should be less than 15%. The index report must be annexed with detailed manuscript.

REFERENCING STYLE:

List references in alphabetical order. Each listed reference should be cited in text, and each text citation should be listed in the References section. The APA referencing style (7th edition) should be followed in manuscript
